



Repository Fees for Paleontological Material

Effective for material received at WSC through December 31, 2012

Upon receipt of collections, the Western Science Center (WSC) assumes responsibility for their stewardship of these non-renewable resources that document our natural and cultural heritage. Collections are stored in an environmentally controlled facility with state-of-the-art collections storage equipment and supplies according to professional standards.

WSC adheres to professional standards for collections stewardship, registration and conservation as recommended by professional paleontological and museum associations including the American Association of Museums, the Society for the Preservation of Natural History Collections, and the American Institute for Conservation and Society for Vertebrate Paleontology. WSC staff consult with specialists when materials or situations require expertise beyond that provided by WSC professionals.

* Prices are based on a standard 15 x 12 x 10-inch archival storage box with 30 lbs. weight limit; or standard quarter-unit style steel cabinet (interior dimensions = 25 x 30 x 32.5-inch; 10-15 drawers)

** "Oversize objects" are those that cannot be stored in a standard box due to size, shape or weight; a surcharge will be assessed for objects or materials that require customized housing or environmental controls, and all additional fees will be negotiated at the time of contract.
